Temple and Tomb Presentation — May 26, 2007 — Beaverton, OR

I scheduled a lecture which will be a visual presentation of Dr. Ernest L. Martin's Temple information. That information shows that the proper location of the Jewish Temples in Jerusalem was above and west of the Gihon Springs. The proper location was south of the false "Temple Mount" (the Haram esh-Sharif), which is the present site of the golden Dome of the Rock and the al-Aqsa Mosque. That is Part 1 of the lecture.

In Part 2 of the lecture I shall show the location and future discovery of the Tombs of the Jewish Kings David and Solomon. These Tombs are in close proximity to the correct Temple location. Dr. Martin's Temple research gives vital clues to the location of the Tombs at Jerusalem. Historical and biblical sources indicate clearly that the bodies of King David, Solomon, and possibly others are in the Tombs. It is believed that the Tombs are intact and will yield more important information and documents than any ancient tomb, including the Tomb of King Tutankhamen.

Beaverton is a nearby western suburb to Portland, Oregon, where the ASK offices are located. This event is open to the general public, of course, due to free use of the public library facility. The library is a large 2-story structure, facing south, in a residential area.

One God Conference — June 8–10, 2007 — Albany, NY

I have been accepted as the "contrarian" speaker at this year's One God Conference. It is my understanding that the main idea for this conference is to refute trinitarianism. Most of the speakers will present on Friday, June 8th and Saturday, June 9th. I shall present on Saturday.

My presentation shall be in general agreement to the main concept of the conference (I agree that the Trinity is not found in Scripture), I will present my understanding of the Holy Scriptures on these matters. With reference to the issues under discussion in the "One God Conference," the apostle Paul was quite clear:

"For though there be that are called gods, whether in heaven or in earth, (as there be gods many, and lords many,)

But to us there is but

one God, the Father, [out] of whom [are] all things, and we in him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by [through] whom are all things, and we by [through] him.

Howbeit there is not in every man that knowledge."

• 1 Corinthians 8:5-7

"Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth. For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; Who gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time."

• 1 Timothy 2:4-6

The title of my presentation will be "Elohim and the Son of God." I will show a more expanded understanding of "Elohim" than most have heard, and explain how a full understanding of Elohim relates to and enlarges our understanding of Jesus Christ as the Son of God, the first amongst other sons of God.

I will also deal with the issue of the Word's existence before His birth from Mary's womb when He acquired the name Jesus and Immanuel, a concept which has been challenged by speakers at the conferences in past years. I intend to produce a PowerPoint presentation to put up on the ASK website shortly after the conference.

This is the 6th annual conference on the topic of the One God. I attended the first conference in Seattle, Washington in 2002, and I have been able to review the presentations from the last two years. I certainly thank the organizers for this opportunity to speak. The conference is extremely collegial. Anyone who attends will be well received and welcomed.

I also appreciate that I will be given an extended time to speak, well over an hour, with time for questions after. This generous allotment of time will allow me to deal with and inform on several issues of interest to those attending.

The conference is inexpensive, the cost to attend is a donation of \$15.00. This covers expenses for refreshments, printing of conference papers, and one lunch. Keep in mind however, you must make your own arrangements for lodging and other meals. The organizers will not assist you in this regard. If you can attend, for either of the days, I would be pleased to meet you. If you are in the area, I hope you can attend.
